PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Band Performance

On the weekend I had the pleasure of watching our Training and Concert band compete at the Central Coast Band Festival. This involved a number of Primary School Bands from around the Central Coast. I am proud to say that both our Training and Concert Band finished with a silver medal. Thank you Mr Ramm and Mrs Maloney who were there to organise the children and assist with the performance on the day.

Car Parking

This has reared its ugly head again. Our main priority is the safety of children and unfortunately some community members have put their safety at risk through not following systems. As a result here is a reminder.

1. The front gate will be closed from 8:15 am onwards. Parents will be encouraged to use the kiss and drop zone at the front of the school.
2. Parents wishing to utilise car park facilities will be encouraged to arrive before 8:15 am when the gates will be shut. Gates will be reopened at 2:15 pm.
3. No parents will be able to use the upper car park unless they have evidence of handicapped identification. Two parking spaces have been identified as being handicapped within the school.
4. All parking spaces identified as **RESERVED** are to be used by **STAFF ONLY**. Empty spaces can be used by general public. These have been identified as being in the lower car park. (7 spaces coloured Yellow).
5. Parents who apply for a parking permit will need to park in the **lower car park only** and arrange to meet their children near there. Parents will need to reapply for a permit each 5 weeks. These must be displayed on their dash board.
6. Parents and Early Intervention students who arrive at school between the hours of 8:15 am and 2:15 am will need to open the gates to drive through. They will be able to utilise the spare car parks, 2 handicapped spaces and space put aside for our cleaner.
7. All other traffic will need to open and close the gates as they come and go.
