# You can change a bad mood into a good mood if you try.

Everyone feels sad, disappointed, angry or worried sometimes. That's normal. But sometimes you can help yourself feel a little better if you do something or think about something that helps you to feel happier.

# It is important to correctly recognise and name your own feelings.

You can easily make a mistake about what feeling you think you are having. You might think you are feeling angry when you are feeling really scared. The sensations in your body can feel very similar. You can also make a mistake about how strong your feeling is. For example, you may think you are 'furious' when in fact you are only 'annoyed'. They are both words to describe angry feelings but the strengths or intensities are different.
