

The KidsMatter focus for the next two weeks is-

Negative and unhelpful 'self-talk' exaggerates feelings and leads to over-reactions.

No person and no event can make you feel a certain way. It may be understandable that you have a certain feeling in response to an event or another person's behaviour, but what exaggerates your feelings is what you say to yourself about what has happened.

Managing negative feelings involves four tools.

The four tools for keeping uncomfortable feelings under some control are: calming down what's happening in your body, using helpful and calming thinking, using effective calm words to say how you feel and why and finding a strategic way to solve the problem so you can still be friendly.
