## **New Teachers and Classes 2019**

There will be many new faces and assets at Narara Public School in 2019 as our little school grows a tad bigger. Currently we are expecting 64 Kindergarten enrolments which will increase our class numbers from 15 to 16 mainstream classes. With our Early Intervention class it will be 17 classes and I can proudly announce that in 2019 Narara Public School will have two Multi-Categorical classes which will be placed in the two classrooms at the front of the school. This makes a total of 19 classes. MC classes are support units for children who typically have an Autism diagnosis and an additional diagnosis which may be cognitive or physical. Typically around 8 children are placed in each class. We are currently going about the recruitment process for the teachers and teacher's aides.

With many of our teachers having babies or finding permanent employment elsewhere we have currently employed some new faces for 2019. We would like to welcome Mrs Kerryn Surwald and Sally Austin (Sharing), Mrs Carmelina Cascio, Miss Stephanie Goldie and Mrs Taiya Franklin.

There are still a couple of positions to fill as we are waiting to see what is happening to some of our other teachers.
